WHEREAS, Michael Bloss, Facility Manager of The Clifton Park Elks Lodge No. 2466 has requested that the Town issue a Mass Gathering Permit for a party to be held at the Elks Lodge located at 695 MacElroy Road, Ballston Lake, and

WHEREAS, the gathering will be held on Sunday, September 22, 2019, from 9:00AM to 4:00PM, with attendance estimated at 1000± people and 60± vendors, and

WHEREAS, Section 64-3 of the Town Code requires a mass gathering permit for one day events where admission is charged; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Town Board is satisfied with the information provided and that the proposed public assemblage will have no effect upon the public health, safety and welfare of the people and property of the Town of Clifton Park; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby directs that a permit be issued to Clifton Park Lodge No. 2466 to take place on September 22, 2019 from 9:00AM to 4:00PM, upon compliance with Section 103-16 of the Town Code, for a Tent Permit provided that the Town is given a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 naming the Town of Clifton Park as additionally insured no less than 4 weeks prior to the event.
