CLIFTON PARK TO PICK UP WIND STORM DEBRIS
Collection Will Occur During The Week of March 6th

Clifton Park, New York – The wind storm that occurred throughout the day of Thursday, March 2, caused a fair amount of damage throughout the Town of Clifton Park. If you are a homeowner that has had large branches and other tree debris fall on your property due to the storm, please place the branches at the curb. Town crews will be collecting the debris the week of March 6th. The streets north of Route 146 will be cleared Tuesday and Wednesday, and the streets south of Route 146 will be cleared Thursday and Friday. Please note the Town cannot remove trees from private property nor can Town personnel enter private property to remove debris. All debris must be at the curb and less than 12” in diameter.

Clifton Park residents can also bring their yard and tree debris to the Clifton Park Transfer Station located at 217 Vischer Ferry Road during normal business hours.
