## **August 14 - The Mother Goose Jazz Band**

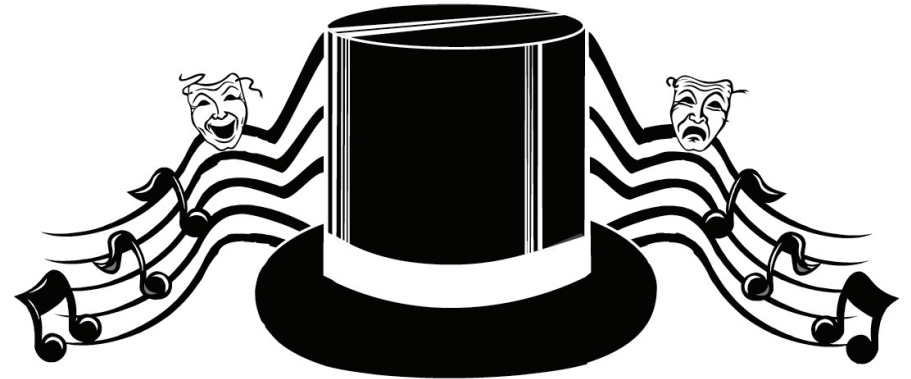
