

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor and material necessary for PIN 1SB1.32 Improved Recreational Access to the Vischer Ferry Nature & Historic Preserve Project will be received by the Town Clerk at the Clifton Park Town Hall, 1 Town Hall Plaza, Clifton Park, NY 12065 until 3:00PM on October 18, 2018 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Bids will be received for the following: Contract No.1 – General Construction: Work includes, but is not limited to, removal and disposal of existing landscape debris, chain-link fence, gravel path, and existing gate; re-profile and formalize gravel parking area; reconstruction of stone dust trail; formalize reception area around existing interpretive sign; installation of bike racks, prefabricated steel truss pedestrian structure, timber guardrail, interpretive signage, fill-type retaining walls, mill and re-profile existing asphalt parking lot.

All Contract Documents may be examined at no expense at the office of Barton & Loguidice, D.P.C., 10 Airline Dr., Suite 200, Albany, New York 12205, between the hours of 8:00AM and 4:45PM Monday through Friday, or at the Town of Clifton Park Town Clerk's Office at Town Hall. Each bid must be accompanied by security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders. No Bidder may withdraw his bid within forty-five (45) days after the actual date of opening thereof.

The Town has scheduled a pre-bid conference at the project site to review specific requirements of this contract. Attendance at this pre-bid conference is recommended but optional. The pre-bid conference will commence on September 28, 2018 at 10:00AM at the Vischer Ferry Nature & Historic Preserve, at the Whipple Truss Bridge entrance on Riverview Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065, and continue at 10:30AM at the Clute's Dry Dock entrance, Riverview Road, Clifton Park, NY 12065.

This is an exempt capital improvement project, and Bidders shall not include in their bid sales and compensating use taxes on the cost of materials which are to be incorporated into the work and which are to be separately sold by the Contractor to the Town of Clifton Park prior to incorporation into the work of the Contract.

In accordance with New York State General Municipal Law Section 101 (a.k.a. "Wicks Law"), all Bidders must include with their Bid a separately sealed list naming each Subcontractor for plumbing, HVAC and electrical work along with the amount to be paid to each.

The attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of

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employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the Contract.

The Sponsor and the New York State Department of Transportation, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation and Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 200, Title VI Program and Related Statutes, as amended, issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all who respond to a written Department solicitation, request for proposal or invitation for bid that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability/handicap and income status in consideration for an award.

The requirements of this contract have the following utilization goals and participation requirements: Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal is 0%; Equal Employment Opportunity goal for Minority Participation is 3.2%; and the Women's Business Enterprise goal is 6.9%.
